

Florida Botanical Gardens' Flowers



In the Tropical Fruit Garden, look for the strange flowers of banana trees. Individual flowers are creamy-white and tube-shaped. Each flower will develop into one banana. The flower clusters are protected by a bright, red hood.



The Potato Tree flowers nearly year-round. Bees and flies like to feed on its pollen.

The Bird of Paradise comes from South Africa, where birds land on the bright flowers looking for nectar.



Look for Blue Plumbago throughout the gardens. Butterflies love this plant, especially the little Ceraunus Blue, one of Florida's smallest butterflies. Look for them flying quickly around Plumbago.
